Philip Ney is a child and family psychiatrist and developmental child psychologist now retired from the Department of Family Medicine, University of British Columbia, Vancouver. He was educated at U Victoria, U British Columbia, McGill, U London (England) and U of Illinois earning MD, Dip Psych, DPM, FRCP (C), FRANZP. He taught at McGill, UBC, U Calgary, U Hong Kong and Otago U and has been a clinical and academic department chairman. His research into the root causes of child autism, hyper-activity, child abuse and neglect led to the discovery of the significant reciprocal correlations between child mistreatment and abortion. His investigation into the effects in children and adults of being an abortion survivor has led to insights into the roots of psychiatric conditions that stem from existential guilt. He has appeared as an expert witness in abortion related suits in 5 countries. He discovered

the inverse relationship between rates of breast feeding and abortion. He founded and taught the Hope Alive method of group counseling in over 35 countries. Philip lectured to academic and lay audiences in many centers including Moscow and the House of Lords London. He founded the International Society of Centurions and conducts rehabilitation programs for medical staff who quit performing abortions. Together with his pediatrician wife Marie, he now runs a small prolife college

Dr. Donna J. Harrison is a board certified obstetrician and gynecologist and Executive Director of the Am. Asso. Of Prolife Obstetricians /Gynecologists. Trained at the University of Michigan, Former Chairman of Dept of OB/GYN at Lakeland Regional Health Systems, MI, is an Adjunct Professor at Trinity International University in Deerfield, IL. She has lectured extensively as a Continuing Medical Education Speaker in the US and Internationally on topics of Medical Abortion, Emergency Contraception, Maternal Mortality in association with Abortion, and Post Abortion Short and Long Term Complications. She has spoken before FDA Reproductive Health Advisory Committees on Mifepristone and Ulipristal and has addressed numerous congressional committees, as well as presenting at the United Nations Committee on the Status of Women accessory sessions on topics related to Medical Abortion in developing nations, and Maternal Mortality and Abortion.

Topics: Evidence to show that abortions are not safer than full term pregnancies. Evidence for the reciprocal relationship between abuse and abortion. The hormonal reasons explaining the greater number of breast cancers following an abortion. How children and men are damaged by abortions: the Abortion Survivor. The destructive impact from providing abortions on the medical profession. Dehumanization is the common effect from both abuse and abortion. How to regain your humanity power balance and dignity with Hope Alive Counseling.

Rationale: Although the world was promised that the rates of child abuses and neglects would diminish with the introduction of freely available abortion, the opposite occurred. There was a parallel increase in rates of abuse and abortion. Was this because the more children became objects to want or discard, the more they lost their intrinsic value? The less valuable they became the easier it was to neglect and/or sexually and/or physically and/or verbally abuse them? The more they were devalued the more their injured self-esteem kept them from defending themselves? Or was there other reasons both biochemical, psychological and spiritual that underlay all of these mechanisms? Dehumanization is one important clue. After a life time of clinical and experimental observations, we have some important leads every life maintaining or life enhancing professional should know about. Moreover we have discovered an effective, efficient method of helping heal many of the major wounds.

2. Recognize the abortion survivor syndrome and how existential conflicts often result in persistent mental health problems in children and adults
